#### **Good Friday Tenebrae Service**

The service of Tenebrae, meaning "darkness" or "shadows," has been practiced by the church since medieval times. Today we join Christians of many generations throughout the world in using the Tenebrae format. Tenebrae is a prolonged meditation on Christ's suffering and death, for us and for our salvation.
