Of old you spoke in a vision to your godly one, and said:

- "I have granted help to one who is mighty; I have exalted one chosen from the people.
- ²⁰ I have found David, my servant; with my holy oil I have anointed him,
- ²¹ so that my hand shall be established with him; my arm also shall strengthen him.
- ²² The enemy shall not outwit him; the wicked shall not humble him.
- ²³ I will crush his foes before him and strike down those who hate him.
- ²⁴ My faithfulness and my steadfast love shall be with him, and in my name shall his horn be exalted.
- ²⁵ I will set his hand on the sea and his right hand on the rivers.

To call My true love to My dance.


Advent Liturgy

Reader: Tonight, the Advent season ends. We wait no longer. That great event for which we waited has happened. God's promise of a Redeemer is fulfilled. Christ Jesus is born. We light the Christ candle with praise to our God who brings joy to the world. Let us remember the hope that we have, promised by the prophets and fulfilled in Jesus.

Lighting of the Advent Candles

Scripture: For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people. It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, while we wait for the blessed hope—the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a people that are his very own, eager to do what is good. -Titus 2:11-14

All: Lord Jesus Christ, tonight we celebrate your lowly coming as a baby in Bethlehem even as we wait for your glorious appearing on the clouds of heaven. In your coming, you have shown your majesty and splendor and have put a new song in our hearts and lives. We give thanks for your redeeming work, which assures us of victory, for the power of your Spirit that enables us to say "no" to sin and "yes" to righteousness, and for your love, which forgives us when we fail. Help us to live today and always as your sons and daughters. Rule in us today that through us your ways may be known on earth, your salvation among all nations. In your mighty name we pray. Amen.



In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world. ² (This was the first census that took place while Quirinius was governor of Syria.) ³ And everyone went to their own town to register.

⁴ So Joseph also went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to Bethlehem the town of David, because he belonged to the house and line of David. ⁵He went there to register with Mary, who was pledged to be married to him and was expecting a child. ⁶ While they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, ⁷and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger, because there was no guest room available for them.

⁸ And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. ⁹ An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. ¹⁰ But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. ¹¹Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. ¹² This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger."
